Germany’s oldest theatre stage, which has been performing continuously since 1607, and the Lake Constance Philharmonic Orchestra fascinate audiences all year round with high-quality performances. Top events such as the Stadtgartenfest, the Jazzherbst, the open-air theatre, the music festival, the legendary Fasnacht carnival and many other cultural highlights offer a wide range of events at any time of year. And conference locations such as the Bodenseeforum as a modern conference, congress and event centre directly on the Seerhein, the historic Konzil at the harbour or the Steigenberger Inselhotel directly on the lake are also worth seeing ...

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## SHOPPING, SIGHTSEEING AND EATING OUT

Shopping tours with historical flair, enjoyable restaurant visits, cosy markets and exciting leisure activities: Visitors can explore the picturesque centre on foot from the market square. More than 400 specialist shops in the old town and the LAGO, the largest shopping centre on Lake Constance, fascinate with a balanced, high-quality mix of shops.

Nice cafés, wine taverns and restaurants with regional specialties invite guests to enjoy and linger - in the harbour with views of the lake and the Alps and in the old town, e.g. in the oldest part of town, Niederburg, with its romantic alleyways.

Discovery tours on and in the water: SEA LIFE with its underwater world, scenic boat trips or a relaxing end to the day in the thermal baths create unique moments of happiness.
